Companion Cards



The Companion Card Program is designed to assist people with a significant, permanent disability who need a companion to provide attendant care support to attend community venues and activities. Presentation of the card to affiliated venues entitles their companion to free admission when assisting the cardholder.

Benalla Rural City Council has been affiliated with the Companion Card Program since 2005 and ensures all of its owned, managed or funded venues, events and activities adhere to the terms and conditions of the program.




Benalla City Centre Mobility Map

Hearing loops
